Position Summary:

The pianist accompanies the Perfect Harmony Chorus, reports directly to and works with the Artistic Director. The pianist promotes the artistic direction and development of the Chorus consistent with established mission, vision, values and goals of the organization, as set forth by the Artistic Director and Board of Directors.

Perfect Harmony is currently hiring for a pianist with a start date of January 1st, 2023.

Primary responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- A. Accompany at regular rehearsals on Sundays from 6:00pm-9:00pm from the end of August through early June.
- B. Assist rehearsal through the playing of rehearsal parts from choral scores.
- C. Accompany at fall and spring retreat rehearsals, typically in mid-October and mid-March.
- D. Accompany at specially called rehearsals, as needed (i.e. dress rehearsals, etc.)
- E. Accompany at fall and spring concerts, fall fundraiser, and spring cabaret events.
- F. Accompany at potential additional performances (extra stipend available).
- G. Lead rehearsals and/or sectionals as needed.
- H. Assist with the selection of soloists and guest performers.
- I. Maintain consistent communication with the Artistic Director.

Qualifications:

- Experience with accompanying a choral ensemble.
- Experience in choral “open score” reading.

- Ability to play within a wide variety of musical genres (eg Jazz, Classical, Pop).
- Sunday availability to attend weekly rehearsals.
